

Travelling to Kesslers International, Stratford

By Air: London City Airport is within easy reach of Stratford (15 minutes by car or taxi) and has regular scheduled flights to all parts of the UK and Europe.

By Rail: Stratford Station is a main line station with regular service connections to Central London and elsewhere.

By Underground: Stratford Station is on the Central and Jubilee Lines. Mile End Station is on the District and Central Lines.

By Docklands Light Railway: Terminates at Stratford Station.

By Road:

From the M25 North: Leave at Junction 27 and join **M11** South. Continue along the **M11** to its end and join the **A406** - North Circular (S). After 1/2 mile leave the **A406** via slip road to join **A12** (following signs to Central London Docklands). Continue on **A12** through underpass following signs to Blackwall Tunnel. Take Stratford exit, **A118** and turn left at the Bow Interchange onto the **A11** (direction Stratford). Turn right at the second set of traffic lights into Rick Roberts Way, where you will find Kesslers International.

From the M25 South: Leave at junction 2. Take the **A2** to London and come through the Blackwall Tunnel. This then becomes the **A102**. Take **A11** exit at Bow Interchange and turn right (direction Stratford). Kesslers International is right at the second set of lights.

From the M4: Follow **M4** to end and onto **A4** to Central London. Go along Embankment, through underpass and follow signs to Whitechapel and **A11**. Follow **A11** straightthrough, over Bow Interchange Flyover and Kesslers International is right at the second set of lights.

On arrival: Please report to reception. Car parking is available adjacent to the reception.
